Risen Christ, by the lakeside you renewed your call to your disciples: help your Church to obey your command and draw the nations to the fire of your love, to the glory of God the Father.

### Post Communion Sentence

God our Father, whose Son Jesus Christ gives the water of eternal life: may we thirst for you, the spring of life and source of goodness, through him who is alive and reigns, now and for ever.

Ascension Day is perhaps a bit overlooked. Coming ten days before Pentecost it marks an important transition between the earthly life of Christ and the beginning of the work of the Holy Spirit as recorded in Acts and beyond. But what does it all mean for us today? We'll be thinking about this at our **Team Ascension Day service at St Peter & St Paul this coming Thursday evening, 30th May at 8pm. Hot-dogs, cake and fizzy drink of various kinds will be served from 7pm to help ease your way into the evening!**

After the very first Ascension Day the disciples gathered, with Mary, devoting themselves to prayer while they waited for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. They, like us, relied on the life-giving gift of the Holy Spirit. Through the centuries Christians have gathered at that time to pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The archbishops' call to prayer - 'Thy Kingdom Come', picks up this tradition. Over the past three years more and more worshipping communities have dedicated the days between Ascension and Pentecost to prayer.

**'Thy Kingdom Come' in the Tring Team Parish** Between Ascension Day and Pentecost, you will find in our churches ideas and practical things to help you pray. Drop in to St P&P, St John the Baptist, or St Cross on any day (and All Saints at the weekend) and there will be creative ways to engage in prayer - prayer stations will offer ways to pray for 5 friends, pray for the world's climate, pray for the things that deeply concern us about the world, and more. There will be things to take away and use in prayer elsewhere, and, as always, the opportunity to simply sit in peace, to light a candle, and to rest in God's presence.

In addition to our regular daily Morning Prayer (to which anyone is always welcome), a short prayer time will take place at St P&P every day at midday (except Sunday). Can't make it to Tring at midday? The prayer booklets will be available for you to take and use wherever you are, either at midday or whenever works for you.

Do come and celebrate Ascension Day on Thursday, and then pop in during the ten days before Pentecost to check out the prayer stations. As we pray 'Thy Kingdom Come' let us consider what God might be calling us to do in our churches, our homes and in our own lives.
