## TRANSFORMING COMMUNITIES

During the course of the year we provide continuing support for; *Christian Aid*; *DENS* and the *FOOD BANK*; *Royal British Legion*; *Local Hospices*; *The Children's Society*, and *Habitat for Humanity*. We plan to build on the relationships we have with these organisations and widen our horizons with the work that goes on with other charities.



During the coming year we will be supporting HemiHelp, a totally unfunded charity for children with hemiplegia which is considered a form of cerebral palsy.

The condition is caused by brain damage, usually acquired before or during birth and is a condition for life. The symptoms are similar to a stroke but unlike a stroke there is no 'cure' or 'getting better' It affects about one child in every thousand, and usually affects one side of the body.

Our local contact for this charity is Martine Roberts a member of the Tring congregation.
