REMEMBERING...

We know how important it is to remember our loved ones. As we share memories, we are reminded of the love which we received from them. Christians proclaim that nothing is able to separate us from the love of God, for love is eternal.

BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

In St Peter & St Paul's in Tring and St John's in Aldbury, there are Books of Remembrance where the names are displayed on the anniversary of their death. Both churches are normally open every day. There is no charge for this but donations are gratefully received.

SERVICES OF REMEMBRANCE

The beginning of November is our time of remembrance. November 1st is All Saints Day when we remember those who have been examples to the church. November 2nd is All Souls Day when we remember those we love who have died. We hold several services of remembrance at this time of year, and read out the names of those whose funerals were held in the previous year. We invite their families to the services, and information will be on the parish website and in the church magazine.

TALKING TO SOMEONE

In many cases, arranging a funeral keeps people so busy that they don't feel their loss fully until afterwards. Grieving is natural and important, and it may take a long time. Many people find that others who have lost a loved one can offer valuable comfort and support. If you would like more information, or just to talk to someone please contact any of the clergy.

A HOUSE OF PRAYER

There are many places and ways in which we remember our loved ones and pray for those who grieve. Sometimes it is useful to have a special place to do this. The churches in Tring, Aldbury and Wilstone are normally open every day so that people can bring their hopes and fears, their joy and sadness to God. You are welcome too.

In each of those churches, there is a votive candle stand so you can light a candle, and somewhere to leave a written prayer. Our prayer ministry team will use these prayers to hold you, and anyone for whom you ask for prayer, in front of God.
