SAFEGUARDING REPORT FOR THE PCC AGM WEDNESDAY 10 MAY 2023

The PCC has complied with its duty to have due regard to House of Bishops guidance on safeguarding children and vulnerable adults.

- All our documents pertaining to Child Protection and Vulnerable Adults are up-to-date.
- You will recall, however, that I persuaded the Diocese to do a C2 course at St P&P on 24 February 2020 which was attended by many of our PCC people **and therefore many will have gone out of date as they need renewing after three years.** I have booked myself on to the first course in April. I will be checking with PCC members to see if they are up-to-date.
- A Parish Statement on Domestic Abuse is in place.
- The list of qualified first aiders displayed in St P&P, has been amended to include details of the nearest defibrillators – in the New Surgery (when open) or locked up outside the police station. A new defibrillator has now been installed on the Vestry Hall wall.
- Could Wardens check if a list of first aiders is displayed in all churches and let me know.
- The Diocese recommends that when a service or other event is held in a church, we notify people with a sign at the entrance that the service will be streamed. This is in place at St P&P.
- We have also requested consents from worship leaders/soloists, etc, to have their faces broadcast.
