While the younger generations learn about other faiths in school, some of us are of the age group where we were only taught about Christianity. So it is a good learning process for me to look up about other faiths and often I do this by looking up the festivals that appear on the calendar in my diary. There are so many similarities: festivals of light, remembering births and deaths of founders; times of learning and fasting; and of course, times of feasting. (I have always thought that I could never be part of a religion that does not include food and hospitality in what it does.) All these festivals are also reminders that what unites us, is stronger than that which divides us.

Our next festival is Ascension Day, Thursday 9th May, when on the 40th day after Easter, we remember the day that the risen Jesus ascended into heaven. I will be honest and say that the physical aspect of this feast is something I have always struggled with; but the spiritual side is that of his disciples needing to learn to live in a new way, of looking forward to the Holy Spirit, and that is much easier for me to understand.

We have two services that day – 10am traditional Holy Communion and 8pm sung Holy Communion, both at St Peter and St Paul, so I do hope you can come and celebrate at one of those.

God upheld by word or wall; power of love beyond all lords of war:

lift us from dullness and cynical contempt; make us ready for your Spirit of transforming fire;

and turn our hearts to the mending of the world;

through Jesus Christ, the name above all names. Amen.
