NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Beacon on the church roof to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. Mindful of the fact that archdeacon's letters of approval were needed for these in 2012, we wrote on 4th May enquiring what permissions were needed and being reassured that there was no new guidance for 2022. We planned accordingly and all of our publicity has included that the event will finish with beacons and pipers on the church roof. A full risk assessment was done and sent to EIG who have noted it in our insurance policy (30/05/22 a Tony Haywood at EIG confirms it is there an no extra premium is needed). The emergency services have been informed, Whilst we note the recommendation to have beacons on ground level we feel it is safer to have the beacon away from the people.

### **Directions to petitioners**

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 30 days, not counting the day on which it is put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
