For a grandparent one of the above three types of relationship must apply between each generation and the next, i.e. between the grandparent and the parent and between the parent and the person completing the form.</p>		
Evidence seen <i>For minister to fill in</i>		
Mother / Father / Parent name surname and occupation Each party can have up to four parents recorded. Where a step parent is included this should be qualified by writing (step parent) after the name. Where a parent is deceased the words (deceased) should be entered after the name. If any parent is retired details of their last occupation should be qualified by writing (retired) afterwards, this should be included even if the parent is deceased.
